

Collaborative Line Art

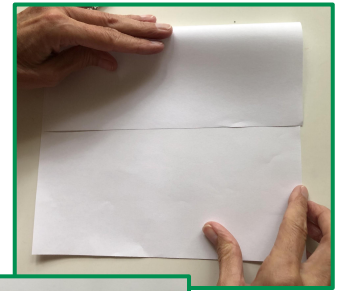
Work with friends or family to use a line drawing to make an original person or creature.



Materials:

- Paper at least 9 x 12 size
- Pencil/colored pencils/crayon/marker

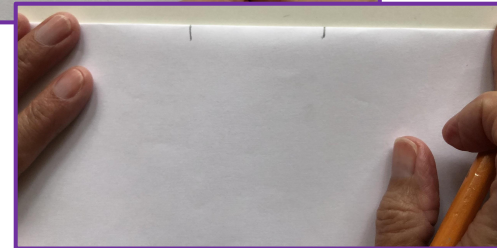
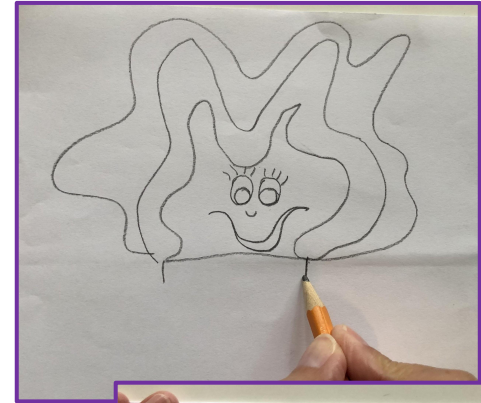
1) Fold your paper into thirds. Then open it.



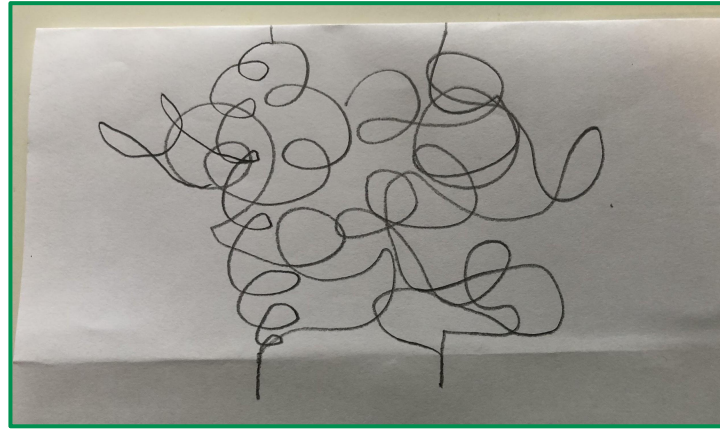
2) On the top third make a line drawing of anything. It can be a face, or anything similar to a face.



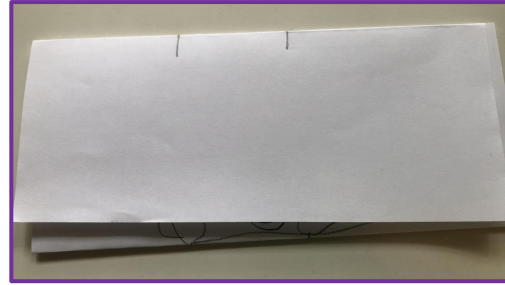
3) Then draw two little lines down into the middle part of the paper. Make sure the two lines cross the fold into the second third. This will act as the neck for the next person to draw a picture in the middle.



4) Pass the drawing to the next person, and in the middle third they can make a line drawing of a body, or something similar to a body. Start the body from the two little neck lines you drew down from the top third.

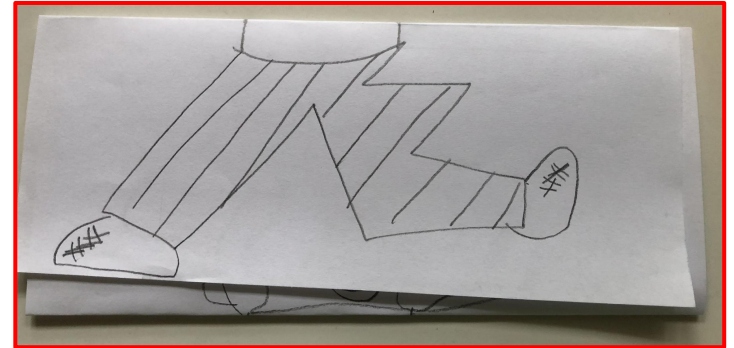


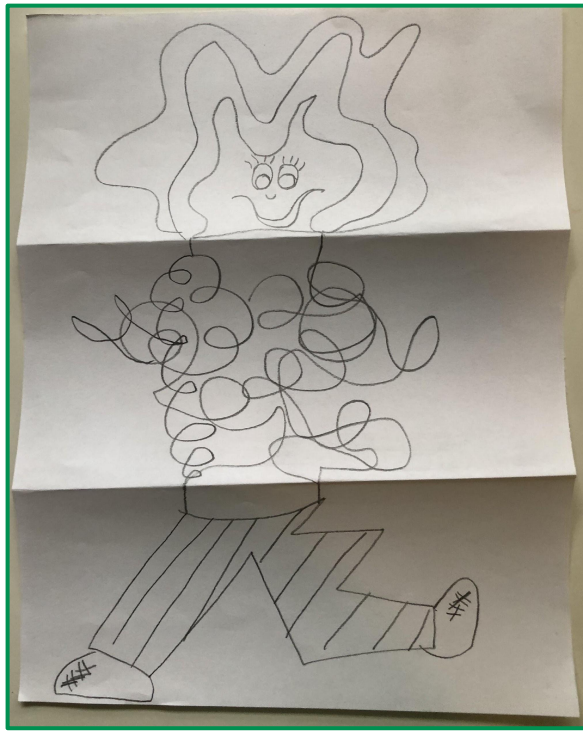
5) When that is done, fold that part to the back and draw two more little lines into the third or last part of the paper. This will help the next person to know where to start. Then pass it to the next person to draw the bottom in the last part of the paper.



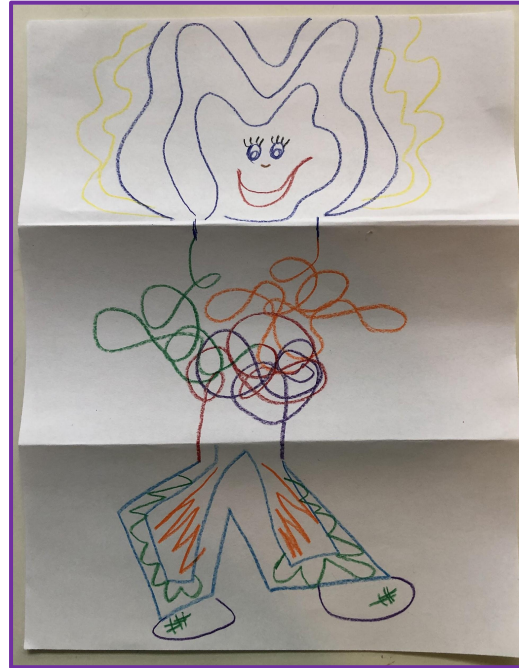
Don't look at the other two parts while they're being drawn. You want to be surprised by the completed drawing when you're done.

6) This last part can be legs or anything you want.

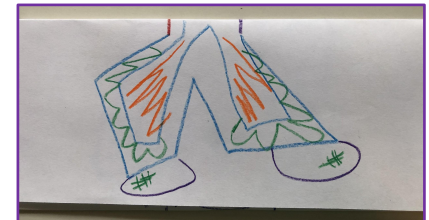
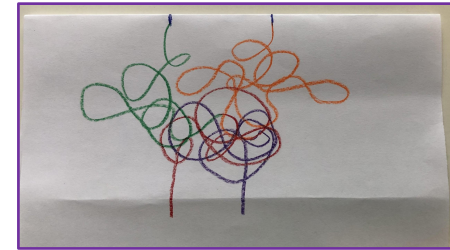
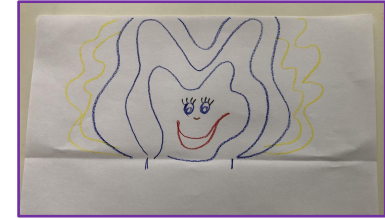




7) Then open the paper and see what kind of person or creature you have made. You can also do this with more than 3 people by just folding the paper into more sections.



8) You can also make the drawing in color if you like.



This type of drawing is called an “Exquisite Corpse.” You never know what you are going to get. Have Fun!!!!!!!
